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## STATE OF CALIFORNIA

### FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

**FEBRUARY 14, 2017**

This evening, February 14, 2017, President Trump issued a major disaster declaration for the State of California triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from the Severe Winter Storms, Flooding, and Mudslides that occurred during the period of January 3-12, 2017. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

Declaration Number: FEMA-4301-DR

Incident: Severe Winter Storms, Flooding, and Mudslides

Incident Period: January 3-12, 2017

Public Assistance (PA): (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities):

PA-Designated Areas: Alameda, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Contra Costa, El Dorado, Humboldt, Inyo, Lake, Lassen, Marin, Mendocino, Merced, Mono, Monterey, Napa, Nevada, Placer, Plumas, Sacramento, San Benito, San Luis Obispo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Sutter, Trinity, Tuolumne, Yolo, and Yuba.

Hazard Mitigation (HM): (Assistance for actions taken to prevent or reduce long term risk to life and property from natural hazards):

HM-Designated Areas: All areas in the State of California are eligible for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER:

Additional designations may be made at a later date if requested by the State and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.

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
